MEETING MINUTES

Local Liquor License Review Committee (LLRC)

Monday, March 26, 2018

City Hall – 5:00 p.m.

CALL TO ORDER: The meeting was called to order at 5:00 p.m. City Commission Members Present - Chairperson Colleen Pobur, and Suzi Deal

APPROVAL OF THE MINUTES: The LLRC Meeting Minutes for January 29, 2018 and March 5, 2018 were distributed in advance of the meeting. Member Deal made a correction to the Minutes of March 5, 2018 and offered a Resolution to approve both sets of meeting Minutes as revised.

MOTION PASSED

NEW BUSINESS:

a) Application to begin operations of a Class C Liquor License for G.I. Poros, Inc. (Greek Islands). There was a brief discussion with the ownership group of Greek Islands and how they are only looking at a small amount of beers and wine at this time. There was also discussion of the outdoor service area and the need for the ownership to approach the Michigan Liquor Control Commission regarding that issue.

It was moved by Member Deal and seconded by Member Pobur:

WHEREAS The City of Plymouth has a Liquor License Management Ordinance and this Ordinance requires that the Liquor License Control Committee (LLRC) review proposed operations of any Class C Liquor License, and

WHEREAS G.I. Poros, Inc. (A.K.A. - Greek Islands) have requested that the City Authorize the ownership of the establishment to operate their Class C Liquor License in accordance with their Submitted Operations Plan as presented to the LLRC on March 26, 2018, and

WHEREAS The City Administration and the LLRC has reviewed the request and found that it does meet the criteria established in the Liquor License Management Ordinance.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT the LLRC does hereby recommend to the City Commission that the request from G.I. Poros, Inc. to operate a Class C Liquor License in accordance with their plan presented to the LLRC on March 26, 2018 to include Sunday Sales (AM), Sunday Sales (PM), Direct Connection, and Outdoor Service permits be approved as presented.

MOTION PASSED

b) Application to begin operations of a Class C Liquor License for Westborn of Plymouth (Westborn Market): The LLRC held a discussion related to the operations of Westborn Market and how the

original calculations related to parking were counted as part retail space and part restaurant space and the establishment exceeds the City's parking requirements at the time the establishment opened.

It was moved by Member Deal and Seconded by Member Pobur;

WHEREAS The City of Plymouth has a Liquor License Management Ordinance and this Ordinance requires that the Liquor License Review Committee (LLRC) review proposed operations of any Class C type Liquor Licenses, and

WHEREAS Westborn of Plymouth, LLC (a.k.a. Westborn Market) have requested that the City authorize the ownership of the establishment to operate their Class C Liquor License with SDM, Outdoor Service Permit, Sunday Sales (AM), Sunday Sales (PM) permits, in accordance with their operational plan submitted to the LLRC on March 26, 2018, and

WHEREAS The City Administration and the LLRC has reviewed the request and found that it does meet the criteria established in the Liquor License Management Ordinance.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT the LLRC does hereby recommend to the City Commission that the request from Westborn of Plymouth, LLC to operate a Class C Liquor License with SDM and the following permits; Sunday Sales (AM), Sunday Sales (PM), and Outdoor Service be approved for operations in accordance with their Operational Plan submitted to the LLRC on March 26, 2018.

Adjournment - Chairperson Pobur asked if there were any other citizen comments and then it was moved by Member Pobur and Seconded by Member Deal to adjourn the meeting.
